**ORBIT INTERNATIONAL'S POWER UNIT SEGMENT RECEIVES NEW ORDERS  
IN EXCESS OF \$800,000**

New Order Enters Production Phase with Potential to Continue Through 2011

Hauppauge, New York, September 21, 2005—Orbit International Corp. (NASDAQ:ORBT) today announced that its Power Units Segment, Behlman Electronics, Inc. (“Behlman”) has received an order for approximately \$650,000, for a power supply used on the LAMPS MK1 SH-2F “Seasprite” program, the U.S. Navy’s anti-submarine and anti-ship surveillance and targeting system. Behlman had previously supplied units during the program’s pre-production phase and this order marks the beginning of the production phase which is expected to continue through 2011.

In addition, Behlman received a follow-on order for approximately \$170,000 for power supplies used on the Wedgetail program, an airborne surveillance system. Deliveries under these contracts are expected to commence in the first quarter of 2006 and continue through the first quarter of 2007.

Mark Tublisky, President of Behlman, commented, “Behlman currently has a significant amount of commercial off-the-shelf (COTS) power supplies designed on programs that have entered their production phase which should continue to generate follow-on orders in the future. In addition, Behlman continues to pursue other COTS programs and currently has delivered several new designs for qualification testing on programs that we believe have large production potential.”

Dennis Sunshine, President and Chief Executive Officer of Orbit International Corp. added, "Behlman continues to see its engineering efforts on COTS programs come to fruition as evidenced by this significant order on the LAMPS program. In addition to these new orders for its custom division, Behlman continues to develop new products for its commercial division as well. The success of both of Behlman's operating divisions has led to the significant increase in revenue and profitability from this operating segment over the past two years."

Orbit International Corp. is involved in the manufacture of customized electronic components and subsystems for military and nonmilitary government applications through its production facilities in Hauppauge, New York and Quakertown, Pennsylvania. Its Behlman Electronics, Inc. subsidiary manufactures and sells high quality commercial power units, AC power sources, frequency converters, uninterruptible power supplies and associated analytical equipment. The Behlman military division designs, manufactures and sells power units and electronic products for measurement and display.
